**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

**Civil Action No. 05-0301 (GK)**

Upon consideration of Petitioner's Motion for an Order to Show Cause Why Respondents Should Not be Held in Contempt and of This Court's October 2005 Order Requiring Notice and Provision of Medical Records for Force-Fed Prisoners, and sufficient cause appearing therefore,
