NOTICE OF SCHEDULING ORDER IN COURT OF APPEALS

Today the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit entered the attached orders in *Al-Odah v. United States*, No. 05-8003, and *Boumediene v. Bush*, No. 05-5062, the appeals upon which Respondents' motion for a stay of this case is based. Although the Court of Appeals has set both cases for expedited briefing, the injury to Petitioners from continued unlawful detention still outweighs the potential prejudice to the Respondents from going forward with this matter pending those appeals. In any event, though, Petitioners hope that the Court will enter a protective order, without delay, in the form previously entered as items 77 and 80 in *El Banna v. Bush*, No. 04-1144 (RWR), as previously requested. Until this is done, Respondents will continue to prevent delivery of counsel's mail to Petitioners.
