ORDER SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

These three cases having been transferred for coordination and management by this Judge, it is hereby

ORDERED that pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2243, respondents shall file with the Court and serve on petitioners' counsel on or before December 28, 2004 responsive pleadings, including motions to dismiss should the respondents wish to file them, showing cause why writs of habeas corpus and the relief sought by the petitioners should not be granted. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that respondents shall file factual returns for the detainees on or before December 28, 2004. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that should respondents file motions to dismiss on or before December 28, 2004, petitioners shall file their oppositions thereto on or before January 13, 2005. The respondents' reply briefs shall be due on or before January 21, 2005.

The amended protective order, including counsel access procedures, previously issued and supplemented in other Guantanamo Bay detainee cases, will apply to these cases and will be docketed in separate entries.
