## ORDER

Upon consideration of the Supreme Court's judgment, granting appellants' petition for writ of certiorari, vacating this court's judgment, and remanding the case, Paracha v. Bush, No. 07-153 (U.S. Jun. 23, 2008); appellees' motion to govern further proceedings; appellants' suggestion and revised suggestion to govern further proceedings and the responses thereto; and appellants' motion for immediate relief and the response thereto, it is

**ORDERED** that Nos. 05-5194, 05-5211, and 05-5333, and the motion for immediate relief be dismissed as moot in light of the district court's lifting of the stay, disposition of appellants' stay motion, and ongoing proceedings in the habeas action, Civ. Action No. 04-2022; and in light of the representations of appellants' counsel that the claims presented in No. 05-5333 pertaining to conditions of confinement are moot.

The Clerk is directed to withhold issuance of the mandate in Nos. 05-5194 and 05-5333 until seven days after resolution of any timely petition for rehearing or petition for rehearing en banc.
