**FURTHER NOTICE OF ACTIVITY IN GUANTÁNAMO CASES**

Petitioners in the above-captioned cases respectfully submit this further notice of activity in the Guantánamo cases. On July 26, 2007, the D.C. Circuit recalled the mandates in *Al Odah v. United States*, Case Nos. 05-5064 *et al.* (D.C. Cir.), and *Boumediene v. Bush*, Case Nos. 05-5062 and 05-5063 (D.C. Cir.). The *Al Odah* order is attached as Exhibit 1 and the *Boumediene* order is attached as Exhibit 2. The recall of these mandates, which had ordered the dismissal of the *Al Odah* and *Boumediene* petitioners’ pending habeas cases, further underscores that dismissal of Petitioners’ cases is inappropriate.<sup>1</sup>
