ORDER

Before the Court is the “Motion by Respondents for Enlargement of Time to File Factual Return Re Jamal Muhammad ‘Alawi Mar’i (ISN 577) and Notice of Ex Parte, In Camera Submission in Support of Motion” [#670]. Petitioner objects to the submissions that have been presented to the Court in support of the motion being considered *ex parte*.
