ORDER CLARIFYING JUNE 4, 2009 ORDER

On June 4, 2009, the court issued an order granting respondent's motion for partial reconsideration of the court's April 8, 2009 discovery order [#524]. In that order the court required respondents to perform a search for forms of a petitioner's statements relied on by the government and information about the circumstances under which those statements were made that is "reasonable under the circumstances." *See Abdah v. Obama*, 1:04-cv-1254 (June 4, 2009). In this order, the court clarifies that it considers any information that the government reviews or obtains while implementing the President's January 22, 2009 executive order to be within the scope of a search that is "reasonable under the circumstances." *See* Exec. Order No. 13492 § 4(c)(1), 74 Fed. Reg. 4897, 4898 (January 22, 2009).

Accordingly, it is this 18th day of June 2009, hereby

ORDERED that with respect to the information required to be disclosed pursuant to paragraphs (3) and (4) of the court's April 8, 2009 order, respondents must produce any responsive information that the government reviews or obtains while implementing the President's January 22, 2009 executive order.
